## CAÑIZARES FUND

The Cañizares Fund provided through the generosity of Roberto Cañizares, BS'71. MBA '74, provides a subsidy for a summer internship in emerging markets and also provides travel monies for international case competitions.

The Cañizares fund for international internships is intended to supplement salaries that are significantly less than the average MBA internship salaries or to provide compensation for unpaid internships. The amount of funding provided to selected students will vary, based on the fund. Unfortunately these funds cannot be used for international students who are returning to their home country for a summer internship. Funds are awarded based on merit and need.

To apply for the Cañizares fund please submit a statement of interest that includes the following details:

- your cv,
- a description of your internship; start and end dates; notes on the relevance of the internship to your academic and career goals
- list of any compensation you'll be receiving, including housing, travel, salary, or stipend
- the basis of your need or a description of your financial status, to include a list of grants, awards, financial fellowships, or loans you have already received at Johnson or expect to receive and
- your academic performance,

If you're participating in an international case competition or a case competition with a global theme please contact us with competition details and your travel budget. Please send your application to [ContactEMI@cornell.edu](mailto:ContactEMI@cornell.edu).

You will receive a response to your request two weeks after you submit your application. As we have a limited number of funds we are not able to award funding for all of the applicants.

If you are awarded funding for your internship or case competition you will need to submit:

1. 600-800 word essay/article about your experience in the competition or internship,
2. photos taken during trip,
3. detailed receipts, with a description of purchase, up to the amount awarded and
4. Thank you message to Roberto Canizares.

All funds will be awarded as a reimbursement after all the above items have been submitted.
